



# FAQ'S

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Saint Susanna School by the Numbers:

- Saint Susanna School offers K - 8th Grade, three classes per grade level
- Max class sizes: 25 students/class (Kindergarten, includes full-time aide for each K class), 26 students/class (1st & 2nd grade), 28 students/class (3rd-8th grade)
- School hours: 8:10 am to 3:00 pm. Drop off time: 7:50 am - 8:10 am
- Office hours: 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Flex-day Kindergarten is 8:10 am to 11:50 am
- Current enrollment for the 2017-18 school year is 697 students
- 2017-18 tuition is \$3,985 (parishioner) \$5,025 (non-parishioner)
- Offering full day and flex-day kindergarten programs; unique flex-day option allows students to begin the year as half-day and transition to full-day at/before the start of the third trimester in mid-March; half-day tuition rate is \$2800/year
- Five local school districts provide busing to Saint Susanna including Mason, Lakota, Lebanon, Kings and Little Miami; Several local child care facilities also bus to and from Saint Susanna
- Students wear uniforms which consist of navy blue shorts/pants, red or white polo shirts, or plaid jumpers/skirts for the girls. Uniforms available through Educational Outfitters or Land's End
- Dedicated cafeteria space with daily hot lunch served
- Saint Susanna Titan sports are run by the Parish Booster program which offers seven sports/activities for boys and girls starting as early as Kindergarten
- 94% of 2017 graduates continued their education at area Catholic high schools including Bishop Fenwick, St. Xavier, Ursuline, Moeller and Mount Notre Dame

### Spiritual Development Opportunities:

- Saint Susanna School is part of Saint Susanna Parish which has vibrant ministry programs for adults, children and families
- Students attend **weekly** school mass at church with the school and parish community where they may participate as lectors, servers, cantors, Eucharistic Ministers or as part of the school choir
- Students prepare for and receive sacraments with the school/parish community
- Students lead morning prayer, Pledge and daily announcements
- Second Step Character Development program is utilized in K-8th
- Service projects throughout the year as well as service hour requirements 6th-8th

### Registration and Open House

- New family registration begins **Tuesday, January 16th, 2018** and ends Thursday, February 18th, 2018. Registration may take place during school office hours M-F from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm or on Sunday, January 28th, 2018 at Open House
- Families should submit a completed registration form, a copy of their child's birth certificate and baptismal records (if applicable). A registration fee of \$100 per person or \$150/family is also due at registration and will be applied toward tuition for the following school year. Admission criteria can be found on our website.
